



# FRENCH KEY STAGE 4 YEAR 9

### TOPIC 1: ME, MY FAMILY AND FRIENDS

Students will revise regular and irregular present tense and the near future to talk about family and friends and to be able to discuss the advantages/disadvantages of different relationship scenarios.

### TOPIC 2: HOME, TOWN, NEIGHBOURHOOD AND REGION

Students will be able to describe their homes, towns, neighbourhoods and regions.

### TOPIC 3: MY STUDIES

Students will be able to discuss what school subjects they study, likes and dislikes and describe their school. They will learn how to use modal verbs, comparatives and superlatives and when to use "tu" and "vous".

### TOPIC 4: MUSIC, CINEMA AND TV

Students will revise KS3 vocabulary and be able to discuss music, going out, cinema and TV. Consolidation of irregular present tense verbs.

### TOPIC 5: SPORT FOOD AND EATING OUT

Students will be able to talk about their favourite sport, likes and dislikes and to talk about food, meals and going to a restaurant.

### TOPIC 6: CUSTOMS AND FESTIVALS IN FRENCH SPEAKING COUNTRIES AND COMMUNITIES

Customs and Festivals in French-speaking countries and communities, revision of perfect tense using avoir/être.
