



GERMAN KEY STAGE 4

Topic: School

Students will learn vocabulary related to school uniform, buildings and subjects. Grammatically, the focus will be on verbs in the present tense and adjectival endings.

Topic: Friends and Relationships

Students will learn vocabulary to describe people (friends and family) and their relationships with others. The grammar will center on the dative case, revising adjectival endings verbs in the present tense and introducing the past tense.

Topic: Holidays

Students will learn vocabulary to describe travel and tourism. The grammar of the past tense will be revised and the future tense introduced.

Topic: Future plans

Students will learn vocabulary related to employment, university, marriage and family. Modal verbs are introduced as they work in a similar way to the future tense, along with concepts about word order.

Topic: Environment

Students will learn vocabulary to describe environmental problems and solutions. The grammar focus will continue to be on modal verbs predominantly.
